Thursday, November 7, we will have a special harvest program presented by Brookside Museum. This is a great hands on program for the children to learn more about how harvest worked during earlier times.

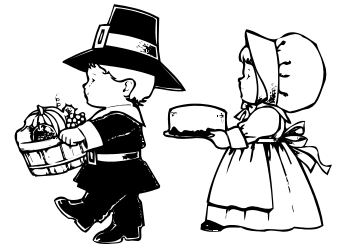
On Friday, November 22 the children will get the chance to pretend to be pilgrims. They will don
